BREAKING MYTHS ABOUT GOD'S LOVE

1 Myth: God's Love is Conditional
Many believe God's love depends on their actions, achievements, or perfection. But Scripture reminds us otherwise: "God demonstrates His love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us" (Romans 5:8). His love does not hinge on your performance; it's rooted in His unchanging character. God loves fully, freely, and without pretense.

2 Myth: Hardship Equals Punishment
When trials come, it's tempting to see them as signs of God's displeasure. But hardships aren't punishments—they're opportunities for growth. They're not meant to harm but to reveal what's deeper and stronger within us. Hebrews 12:6 tells us "For the Lord disciplines those He loves." CHOOSING TRUST OVER FEAR

PRACTICAL STEPS TO EMBRACE AND TRUST GOD'S REFINING LOVE

1 Daily Surrender Through Prayer

Surrounding yourself with believers provides strength and accountability during difficult seasons.
