1 Adrian Despres: Don't Waste Your Life

Adrian Despres has one message: give it all to Jesus. He calls people to a faith that's all-in, not lukewarm. His passion is so contagious that it's not uncommon for dozens or even hundreds of people to respond to his invitations at youth camps and college events. Adrian doesn't pull any punches, but his directness is rooted in a desire for freedom. He combines humor with conviction and is known for opening the floor to tough questions, creating a space for honest, life-changing conversations about sin, forgiveness, and purpose.

Book Adrian Despres If: You want to challenge an audience, especially teens and young adults, to move from passive faith to wholehearted surrender.

2 Caleb McNaughton: Find Your Purpose in Christ

Caleb McNaughton is a master of blending laughter with real talk. His high-energy, Bible-centered style keeps everyone engaged, while his transparency bridges generational gaps. Caleb specializes in reaching people who feel far from God, helping them rediscover their purpose. Event organizers praise his ability to make the Gospel clear, accessible, and urgent. He's the ideal speaker for university chapels and youth gatherings that want a message that's both high-energy and high-impact.



Book Caleb McNaughton If: Your event aims to reach those new to faith or disconnected from it and needs an engaging, relatable voice to make the urgency of the Gospel resound.



3 David Yirdaw: Live Your Faith, Don't Just Talk About It

For David Yirdaw, discipleship isn't just a topic—it's a way of living. He emphasizes relational, "life-on-life" mentoring, showing how faith can be woven into every ordinary moment. David's teaching is both deep and simple, breaking down massive truths into practical, daily habits. His stories of wrestling with doubt and discovering freedom in Jesus resonate with a wide range of people, proving that genuine spiritual formation is a journey we take together.

Book David Yirdaw If: You want to inspire an audience to move beyond head knowledge and into the practical habits of a deep, relational faith.

4 Dwight Robertson: You Are God's Plan A

Dwight Robertson ignites hearts by championing a powerful truth: each person is sent by God to make a difference. His events are infused with energy and a call to action, helping people discover their unique gifts for Kingdom Laborership. Through stories of everyday believers—from neighbors to teachers—Dwight shows how faith can impact every sphere of life. After a session with him, audiences are left inspired to be a part of God's plan.



Book Dwight Robertson If: You want your audience to be mobilized for outreach, and missions, and you want them to see their everyday lives as a mission field.



5 John Vermilya: From the Sidelines to the Front Lines

With the intensity of a sports coach, John Vermilya challenges audiences to stop living a "sideline faith" and get in the game. He uses vivid sports metaphors to speak powerfully about the thrill and cost of living for Christ. Young athletes and teams especially connect with his message of courage, risk, and teamwork in pursuing God. John is the perfect fit for high school and collegiate events that want to inspire a fresh sense of unity and mission.

Book John Vermilya If: Your event focuses on inspiring courage, teamwork, and taking risks for God, especially for athletic teams or young, competitive audiences.

6 Jonathan Sherwin: Move Beyond Checklist Christianity

Jonathan Sherwin isn't afraid to call out easy, surface-level faith. His preaching is full of conviction, inviting people to move past a "checklist Christianity" toward whole-life surrender. While his approach is direct, it's always rooted in deep compassion. He's a strong fit for men's events and student retreats, especially for audiences wrestling with doubt or needing a spiritual course-correction. As one leader noted, "He addressed issues nobody else would touch, but always pointed us back to hope."



Book Jonathan Sherwin If: Your audience is spiritually stagnant or in a dry season and needs a direct, compassionate voice to confront tough issues and call them back to a genuine walk with Christ.



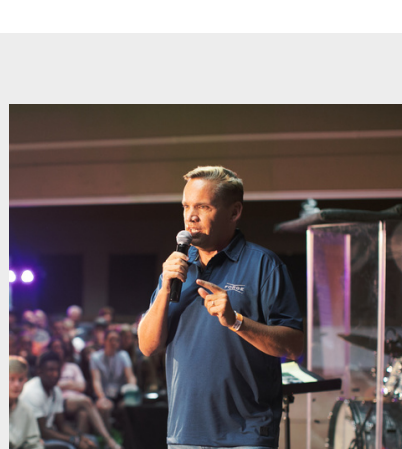
7 Melissa Motschenbacher: Find God in the Little Things

Melissa Motschenbacher uses her own story of transformation to help others find intimacy with God in the everyday. She has a unique voice that resonates with women and youth, offering a vulnerable and practical invitation to "walk with God in the little things." Her warmth and authentic storytelling empower people to see their relationship with God not as a chore, but as the heartbeat of their Christian life.

Book Melissa Motschenbacher If: You want to inspire men, women, or youth to see how God is at work in their daily lives and build a more intimate relationship with Him.

8 Mick Veach: Become a "Water Walker"

Mick Veach invites crowds to live as "water walkers." Drawing from years of urban church planting and international missions, he makes risk-taking for the Gospel feel both accessible and necessary. Mick is particularly gifted at mobilizing large groups of planters. He reminds listeners that the Christian life isn't a checklist—it's an adventure with God.



Book Mick Veach If: Your event is focused on missions, community outreach, or evangelism and you need a speaker to challenge people to step out in bold, adventurous faith.



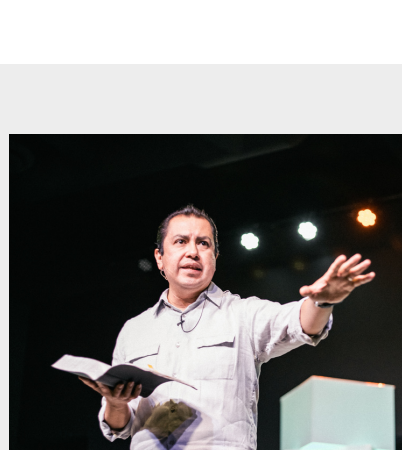
9 Paul Epperson: Equip the Next Generation

Santiago Fuentes cuts through complacency with unfiltered passion. As a bilingual Spanish speaker, he reaches across cultures, igniting revival in churches and inspiring courage on a global stage. Santiago is at home in both intimate prayer retreats and packed city festivals, constantly urging leaders and congregations to return to authentic Biblical truth. His raw honesty and practical steps for spiritual growth attract a wide range of listeners.



Book Santiago Fuentes If: You want to spark genuine revival and challenge leaders to return to the core of biblical truth, particularly for a cross-cultural or Spanish-speaking audience.
